

# Dear Visitors!

Thanks to the low infection rates in Schleswig-Holstein and especially in Dithmarschen, the state government and the district of Dithmarschen have relaxed the visiting regulations for the hospitals.

However, the easing also requires a high degree of personal responsibility from all of us. Based on the legal regulations, we have developed the following rules for visiting our clinics in Brunsbüttel and Heide.

- Patients may generally receive a named person as a visit once a day for a maximum of one hour or twice a day for half an hour each. This person must be of legal age.

Patients with COVID-19 or who are suspected of having a corona infection are not allowed to receive a visit.

In hardship cases, a specialist decides on exceptions to these rules.

Separate regulations apply to the area of the pediatric clinic and the maternity clinic, as well as for the maternity ward. For more information, please refer to the leaflets of the pediatric clinic and the birth center. Visitors to the palliative care unit should contact the station directly.

- Checks take place at the entrance to the clinics. As a visitor, you will be registered by name and must provide information on a possible corona infection. We are legally obliged to register.

Please note that admission controls can lead to waiting times. However, you can help to reduce waiting times by already filling out and signing the registration form. The document is available for download on our website.

- As a named visitor, you will receive a bracelet as proof of your visit permit. This bracelet is non-transferable and should be worn permanently to speed up entry controls. Damaged bracelets will be replaced.
- If there are reasonable doubts about the identity of visitors, our employees are entitled to check your identity with a suitable photo ID.
- If required, you can get medical mouth-nose protection from us.
- In spite of the mask, keep a minimum distance of 1.5 meters from patients and staff.
- Observe the basic hygiene and please disinfect your hands when entering and leaving the clinic and the patient room!
- **Important! Your visit permit expires as soon as you develop cold symptoms or other symptoms typical of a corona infection. In this case, entering the clinic is strictly prohibited by the authorities.**

Thank you very much for observing the rules and making an active contribution against the possible spread of the corona virus.
